The mandatory Scholarship Display Day (where all applicants present themselves, their achievements, and goals to donors) will be held on April 30, 2025, at A.L. Fortune Secondary in the library and running from 10 am – 4 pm. Dress code is “business appropriate”. If a school event leads to your absence, you must provide a poster board to be present. Be sure your poster (you can use your Capstone poster, just tweak it slightly) contains a title, budget, scholarship resume, information about you, your achievements, and your future plans regarding post-secondary schooling. Note – you may or may not be physically present when your poster board is being viewed by all donors, so be thorough that you have displayed everything about yourself and your future plans.

Scholarship eligibility:

To be eligible for an *A.L. Fortune Scholarship/Bursary or Award* the following criteria **MUST** be met:

- Students must graduate in the current graduation year from A.L. Fortune.
- Students must not fail ANY course in their grade 12 year.
- Students must achieve a *minimum 60% overall course average*.
- Students must apply to the scholarship committee and submit all required documents.
