Every year, the BC Ministry of Education provides 5500 District/Authority Scholarships across the province. In School District No. 83, we are lucky to have access to a significant number of these awards. The District/Authority Scholarships are a way to recognize that success at school is more than just academic; it can include other skills and talents as well.

Could you use \$1250.00 toward your post-secondary tuition at a trade school, college, technology institute, or university?

Do you have a skill or talent in one of the following areas?

- Indigenous Languages and Culture
- Fine Arts (Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, or Music)
- Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies (Business, Technology, Home Economics, Information and Communication Technology)
- Physical Activity (not limited to Physical Education)
- International Languages
- Community Service (Volunteering)
- Technical and Trades Training (Carpentry, Automotive, Mechanics, Chef's Training)

Have you developed this skill or talent in depth? Are you willing to demonstrate this skill or talent to a committee? Have you researched post-secondary opportunities, costs, and qualifications?

#### Preparing your Application Package

Prepare an application package that includes the following:

- a cover letter, written by you, to the selection committee:
  - explaining why you are a good candidate for the award based on the category chosen. Hint - the "Evaluation Criteria" has subtitles that should be addressed in your letter
  - o detailing your important achievements (your area of excellence)
- a resume detailing your work and volunteer experience
- the application questionnaire (attached to this package)
- two reference letters:
  - o one that focuses on who you are as a person, and
  - o one that explains your appropriateness in the category chosen
- unofficial transcripts (downloaded from Student Connect)

Please note that this is a significant award, worth \$1250.00. The expectation is that you will take care with your application. Please ensure that your letter and application questionnaire have been edited carefully for spelling and grammar.

### Preparing for your Presentation

Time:	You have a 20-minute slot for your presentation.
	<ul> <li>You must not go over this time, including questions from the panel.</li> </ul>
Prepare:	<ul> <li>Script your presentation; you will probably not use the script when you present but it gives you an idea of the structure.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Rehearse as much as you need to in order to feel comfortable and confident.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Find an adult mentor. Practice in front of your mentor for feedback.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Practice with distractions; these can really "throw you off" when you</li> </ul>
	are presenting.
	<ul> <li>Incorporate visual aids – could be a PowerPoint presentation,</li> </ul>
	performance, demonstration, or display, or
Be Prepared:	<ul> <li>Dress professionally, as if you were going to a job interview, or in</li> </ul>
	clothes that work for your presentation.
	<ul> <li>Be at least five minutes early just in case the panel is ready for you.</li> </ul>
Present:	<ul> <li>Do whatever makes you feel comfortable. The more comfortable you</li> </ul>
	feel, the more confident you feel, and the better things will go.

### Criteria for the District/Authority Scholarship

The District/Authority Scholarships recognize graduating BC students for excellence in their chosen area of interest or strength. These scholarships are intended to provide tuition assistance to students pursuing post-secondary education.

To win a scholarship, a student must apply to the local scholarship committee and:

- ☑ Meet the following basic eligibility requirements:
  - Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident (landed immigrant) at the time of registration in the school year for which the scholarship is awarded;
  - Must be a BC resident;
  - o In the school year in which the scholarship is awarded, must be or have been:
    - o Enrolled in a BC public school (including Distributed Learning schools), or
    - o Enrolled in a Group 1, 2, or 4 BC Independent School, or
    - o Enrolled in a Continuing Education Centre, or
    - Registered with a public, independent, or distributed learning school in BC as a homeschooled child;
- ☑ Meet criteria determined by the local scholarship committee, which requires a student to demonstrate outstanding achievement in any one of the following focus areas:
  - o Indigenous Languages and Culture, demonstrated at school or in the community
  - o Fine Arts (e.g., Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music)
  - Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies (e.g., Business Ed, Technology Ed, Home Economics, Information Communication Technology)
  - Physical Activity (e.g., Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, not limited to Physical Education)
  - International Languages from the International Languages curriculum or External Assessments, including AP and IB courses
  - Community Service (Volunteer Activity), which includes awareness of local, global, and cultural issues
  - Technical and Trades Training (e.g., Carpentry, Automotive, Mechanics, Cook Training)
- ☑ Fulfill the BC Graduation requirements of either the B.C. Graduation Program or the Adult Graduation Program by August 31<sup>st</sup> of the student's graduating year
