Name: A.L. Fortune Dry Grad Award

Criteria:

• Must be a student who leads a socially responsible lifestyle.

Name: A.L. Fortune Hockey Academy

Criteria:

- Good Citizenship at school.
- Good participation, sportsmanship, and leadership as a member of the Hockey Academy.

Name: A.L. Fortune PAC Scholarship

Criteria:

• Students must provide a letter of acceptance to post-secondary education.

Name: A.L. Fortune Staff Bursary

Criteria:

• General/All applications welcome.

Name: A.L. Fortune Volunteer Lunch Program Bursary

Criteria:

 Demonstrate volunteer activities, school involvement, and plan to continue postsecondary education.

Name: Armstrong Regional Cooperative Bursary

Criteria:

- Student who is enrolling in post-secondary institution for full time enrollment in academic year
- Students who have financial needs.
- Student or Parent/Guardian must be an active member of the ARC & in good standing for a minimum of one year prior to bursary application.
- Applications must include the student, parent/guardian co-op number and information.

Name: Askew's Foods Scholarship

Criteria:

- Recipient must be an employee of Askew's Foods (any location) or a child of an employee of Askew's Foods.
- Recipient must enroll in a full college courseload within three of receiving award.
- Proof of enrollment and receipt of tuition payment to be provided prior to receiving award.

Name: Community Foundation of the North Okanagan Bursary Criteria:

• General/All applications welcome.

Name: Enderby & District Arts Council Bursary Criteria:

• To a deserving student planning on further arts education in the fields of music, visual, performance, writing, or digital arts. The bursary must be used within two years and will be paid following proof of enrolment in a post-secondary arts program.

Name: Enderby & District Care Society Bursary (in honor of Twice But Nice volunteers who have passed)

Criteria:

- General/open for tuition only.
- Trade and academic applicants are welcome.

Name: Enderby & District Financial Award Criteria:

This award is open to equity-deserving students which may include students who
identify as BIPOC, living with disabilities or are part of the 2SLGBTQIA+ community.
Preference given to a student who demonstrates financial need. This award aims to
support students in overcoming barriers and succeed in their higher education journey.

Name: Enderby & District Lions Club Mike & Peggy Zemla Memorial Bursary Criteria:

- General/All applications in financial need welcome.
- Students must be involved in an organization or club linked to volunteer work.

Name: Enderby & District Lions Club Scholarship Criteria:

• General/All applications welcome.

Name: Federal French School District 83 Bursary Criteria:

• Student must have taken French 12.

Name: Grant Gerlib Memorial Scholarship Criteria:

- Consideration will be given to students who are enrolling into the health care/medical field.
- Students applying to trades programs may also apply.

Name: Grindrod Recreation Association Bursary Criteria:

• Students must have attended Grindrod Elementary school and live in the Grindrod area.

Name: Hunters Range Snowmobile Association Scholarship Criteria:

- Applicant is a member or has family members who are.
- Preference is given to someone going into a trade, small engine repair.

Name: IODE Lambly Landing Chapter Bursary

- Applicant must be proceeding to post-secondary education (college, vocational or university).
- Applicant must provide proof of enrollment prior to December 31 of your graduating year, to claim bursary.

Name: June & Harry Griswold Memorial Scholarship Criteria:

• Students who are intending to pursue a career in agricultural, horticultural, or environmental studies as well as a food related field.

Name: Mike Ludwig Memorial Bursary Criteria:

• General/All applications welcome.

Name: North Okanagan Shuswap Principals & Vice Principals Association Bursary Criteria:

- Student must represent his or her school well, within both the school and community.
- Academically strong.
- Demonstrate a commitment to the school in the role of leadership, service, and citizenship.
- Intended for a student planning to pursue post-secondary study in an area related to children,

youth, or human services.

- Must be enrolled full-time in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Selected by the ALF Scholarship Committee in consultation with Principals
- & Vice Principals

Association.

• To be paid directly to the student by the North Okanagan Shuswap Principals & Vice Principals

Association based upon submission of proof of enrollment (including course registration and fee receipts) in an accredited post-secondary institution.

Name: North Okanagan Shuswap Teachers Association Scholarship Criteria:

- The applicant must be a top academic student.
- Must be enrolled fulltime in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient in two installments based upon submission of proof of enrollment. The proof of enrollment must be submitted for the fall term and again for the winter/spring term.

Name: Order of the Eastern Star Bursary, Lansdowne Chapter Criteria:

- Masonic or Eastern Star affiliation preference.
- Demonstrate community involvement.
- Open to students pursuing all types of post-secondary education (tuition receipt required).
- Good grades.
- Financial need.

Name: Patrick Romaine Memorial Award

Criteria:

- Community and school involvement.
- Open to all areas of post-secondary.

Name: Real Performance Machinery Scholarship Criteria:

- Must be enrolled fulltime in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Preference given to students pursuing a post-secondary education in Science, Engineering, Math, or Technology.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient upon submission of proof of enrollment.

Name: Riverside Community Club Health and Social Services Scholarship Criteria:

- Open to ANY student at AL Fortune Secondary OR Is a resident of Enderby (or Area F and is homeschooled).
- To provide financial assistance to a student with an interest in pursuing continuing education in: Social work, Police, Medicine, Nursing, Psychology, Psychiatry, Fire Fighter, First Responder, Care Aid etc.
- Recipients will be selected by the current executive of Riverside Community Club based on application materials provided by AL Fortune.
- Payment will be made (until Sept of the following year) to the recipient upon notification and proof of payment to a post secondary educational institution.

Name: Riverside Community Club Scholarship

Criteria:

- Must be a resident of Ashton Creek/Trinity Valley OR Resided in Ashton Creek/Trinity Valley for 3 or more years OR Volunteers at the Riverside Community Hall.
- Must be in their graduating year (they may be graduating from AL Fortune or homeschooled) Recipients will be selected by the current executive of Riverside Community Club based on application materials provided by AL Fortune.
- Payment will be made (until Sept of the following year) to the recipient upon notification and proof of payment to a post secondary educational institution.

Name: Rossworn Henderson LLP Scholarship Criteria:

- \$500/year to be paid at beginning of year once registration into pre-determined courses has been proven. Maximum of 4 years.
- MUST attend Business Administration or Commerce, majoring in accounting.
- RHLLP and recipient shall meet (in-person or virtually) within 90 days of being notified as successful recipient. Funds to be advanced directly from RHLLP to successful candidate.

Name: Royal Canadian Legion Branch #98 Enderby Bursary Criteria:

General/All applications welcome.

Name: Sam and Sheila Peebles Family Scholarship Criteria:

- Applicants must have attended Grindrod Elementary.
- Applicants must be all-round students (academic, athletic, musical and a leader).

Name: Sam Pavelich Memorial Bursary

Criteria:

- Enrolled in trades.
- Students who are interested in heavy duty mechanics.

Name: Santa's Workshop Enderby Bursary

- Community involvement (volunteer).
- Continuing in post-secondary education within 2 years.

Name: Sarah Bradshaw Memorial Scholarship

Criteria:

• Continuing post-secondary education in agricultural, horticultural, or environmental studies, also food related fields are acceptable.

Name: SASCU Award

Criteria:

- Demonstrated success and strong work ethic in the field of post-secondary study.
- Enrolled at an accredited post-secondary institution for a certified certificate, vocational
 or trades program 6 weeks or longer or 6 credits per semester as a part-time university
 studies or business student including programs like Trades Apprenticeship, Trades
 Foundation, Education Assistant, Health Care Assistant, Early Childhood Education,
 Office Administration, etc. as well as fit for part time university transfer & business
 student.

Name: SASCU Scholarship

Criteria:

- Academic achievement
- Community involvement OR School Involvement OR Extraordinary work ethic
- Student **must** be a member of SASCU Credit Union
- Student must be enrolled full-time in an accredited post-secondary learning institution.
- The scholarship must be claimed by the beginning of the second college/university year
 after presentation unless exceptional circumstances prevent enrollment. If the
 scholarship is not claimed by the second year and there are no exceptional
 circumstances, the funds will no longer be available as awarded.

Name: VantageOne Bursary

- Must be a VantageOne member or immediate family member of a member.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Demonstrated a satisfactory level of academic achievement.

Awards/Bursaries/Scholarships – Separate Application Process

Name: Armstrong Spallumcheen Healthcare Auxiliary Bursary Criteria:

- Students must be graduating from ALF.
- Has applied or plans to apply to a full-time healthcare program at a recognized postsecondary institution.
- Volunteer hours and/or demonstrated natural aptitude in the healthcare field.
- A letter addressed to the Armstrong Spallumcheen Healthcare Auxiliary stating proposed field of study in healthcare, details regarding where you have applied and/or been accepted, and your career goals in the healthcare field. Be sure to mention your volunteer hours performed and interests. References are REQUIRED.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See ALF website.

Name: Cam Jammers Car Club Bursary Criteria:

- Students must have applied to a recognized trades program.
- All courses must offer an achievement certificate, diploma, or degree. Courses must be starting within 18 months of graduation.
- Correspondence courses DO NOT qualify for funds.
- A letter of intent must be included with application for bursary (including trades program & institution to which application has been made).
- Funds WILL NOT be dispersed directly to the recipient.
- Funds will be dispersed to the recipient's secondary school bursary committee for transferring to the student's school account at the recognized institution upon proof of enrollment at such institution.
- One award of \$750 for the School District or at the discretion of the committee.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See ALF website.

Name: Carlee de Boer Award

Criteria:

- Graduating and requiring financial assistance for academics or trades.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See ALF website.

Name: CUPE 523 Bursary

- Students graduating whose parent/guardian is a CUPE 523 member in good standing.
- Students who are planning to attend trade, vocational or post-secondary school within the next 18 months from graduation.

Name: Dan Botkin Memorial Scholarship

Criteria:

- School and community involvement.
- Must be attending post-secondary.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See ALF website.

Name: Enderby Pickle Ball Club Bursary

Criteria:

- A.L. Fortune graduate.
- Enrolling in post-secondary education.
- Must have financial need.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See ALF website.

Name: Interior Provincial Exhibition Award

Criteria:

- Awarded to a student who is or has been involved as an IPE volunteer.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See ALF website.

- Applicant's parent(s) or guardians(s) must be members of the MM & AA.
- Applicants must be graduating or have graduated from Secondary School.
- Applicants must be proceeding to post-secondary education (college, vocational or university).
- Preference will be given to full-time students.

The Royal Canadian Legion #98 Bursary and Scholarship

These Bursaries & Scholarships are based primarily on the student's family financial situations and the student's academic standing and contribution to student and community life. Bursaries are awarded to residents of the immediate catchment area of The Enderby Legion.

Applications, including letters of reference, must be received no later than May 15th of the current year.

Completed applications must be returned to RCL Enderby BR #98 (students at A.L. Fortune hand in their applications with their other Local Scholarship & Bursary applications). It is the applicant's responsibility to complete the application in full and to ensure that all related items are submitted by the deadline date.

ALL Applicants must provide the following to expedite the processing of their application. Criteria:

- A complete application form
- Letters of reference
- A statement from the students stating their goals and aspirations
- An official interim report card or transcript
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See ALF website.

The Royal Canadian Legion #98 Poppy Bursary Criteria:

- This applicant must have proof of relationship with a current RCL Enderby #98 Member in good standing, or a documented proof of relationship to a member of their family past or present that served in the Canadian Forces or RCMP.
- Applicants with service in the 3063 Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps shall also be eligible for this bursary.
- Applicants must include 2 reference letters from members of the community, school or
 place of employment. One will support their character and the other will support their
 field of study. A family member is not permitted to write this on their behalf.
- A letter addressed to the scholarship committee stating their future plans. This letter should include their immediate plans after graduation, career goals, volunteer time, post-secondary schools applied/accepted, and financial plans supporting their educational goals.
- ALL Applicants must provide the following to expedite the processing of their application.
 - Letters of reference
 - A statement from the students stating their goals and aspirations
 - An official interim report card or transcript
