**Name: A.L. Fortune Dry Grad Award**

**Criteria:**

- Must be a student who leads a socially responsible lifestyle.

**Name: A.L. Fortune Hockey Academy**

**Criteria:**

- Good Citizenship at school.
- Good participation, sportsmanship, and leadership as a member of the Hockey Academy.

**Name: A.L. Fortune PAC Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Students must provide a letter of acceptance to post-secondary education.

**Name: A.L. Fortune Staff Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- General/All applications welcome.

**Name: A.L. Fortune Volunteer Lunch Program Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Demonstrate volunteer activities, school involvement, and plan to continue post-secondary education.

**Name: Armstrong Regional Cooperative Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Students who are enrolling in post-secondary institution for full time enrollment in academic year
- In need of financial support.
- Student or Parent/Guardian **must be an active member of the ARC & in good standing for a minimum of one year prior to bursary application.**
- Applications must include the student, parent/guardian co-op number and information.

**Name: Armstrong Spallumcheen Healthcare Auxiliary Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Students must be graduating from ALF.
- Has applied or plans to apply to a full-time healthcare program at a recognized post-secondary institution.
- Volunteer hours and/or demonstrated natural aptitude in the healthcare field.
- **A letter addressed to the Armstrong Spallumcheen Healthcare Auxiliary stating proposed field of study in healthcare, details regarding where you have applied and/or been accepted, and your career goals in the healthcare field. Be sure to mention your volunteer hours performed and interests.**

**Name: Askew's Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Must be an employee of Askew's Foods Enderby or a child of a current Askew's Enderby employee.
- Students must be continuing to post-secondary education.

**Name: BCGEU Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Must be related to a BC Government and Service Employees Union member.
- Applicants must complete separate application forms. See school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>Misc Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards)

**Name: Cam Jammers Car Club Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Students must be entering a recognized trades program.
- All courses must offer an achievement certificate, diploma, or degree. Courses must start within 18 months.
- Correspondence courses DO NOT qualify for funds.
- A letter of intent must be included with application for bursary (including trades program & institution to which application has been made).
- Funds WILL NOT be dispersed directly to the recipient.
- Funds will be dispersed to the recipient's secondary school bursary committee for transferring to the student's school account at the recognized institution upon proof of enrollment at such institution.
- One award of \$750 for the School District or at the discretion of the committee.

**Name: Carlee de Boer Award**

**Criteria:**

- Graduating and requiring financial assistance for academics or trades.

**Name: Community Foundation of the North Okanagan Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- General/All applications welcome.

**Name: CUPE 523 Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Students graduating whose parent/guardian is a CUPE 523 member in good standing.
- Students must be planning to attend a trade, vocational or post-secondary school within the next 18 months from the time of graduation.
- Applicants must complete separate application forms. See school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>Misc Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards)

**Name: Dan Botkin Memorial Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- School and community involvement.
- Must be attending post-secondary.

**Name: Don Haak Memorial KODA Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Students must be planning to attend a post-secondary education in agriculture related studies.
- Applicants must complete separate application forms. See school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>Misc Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards)

**Name: Enderby & District Arts Council Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- To a deserving student planning on further arts education in the fields of music, visual, performance, writing, or digital arts. The bursary must be used within two years and will be paid following proof of enrolment in a post-secondary arts program.

**Name: Enderby & District Care Society Bursary** (in honour of Twice But Nice volunteers who have passed)

**Criteria:**

- General/open for tuition only.
- Trade and academic applications are welcome to apply.

**Name: Enderby & District Garden Club Award -- In Memory of Joan Glanfield**

**Criteria:**

- Preference to applicants pursuing post-secondary education in horticulture, environmental studies or conservation
- Preference given to an applicant related to a member of the Enderby & District Garden Club

**Name: Enderby & District Lions Club Bursary – Mike & Peggy Zemla Memorial Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- General/All applications in financial need welcome.
- Students must be involved in an organization or club linked to volunteer work.
- Proof of enrollment required.

**Name: Enderby & District Lions Club Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- General/All applications welcome.
- Proof of enrollment required.

**Name: Enderby Pickle Ball Club Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- A.L. Fortune graduate.
- Enrolling in post-secondary education.
- Must have financial need.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See the school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>A.L. Fortune Local Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards>Separate Applications)

**Name: Federal French School District 83 Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Student must have taken French 12.

**Criteria:**

- Students who intend to pursue a career in agricultural, horticultural, or environmental studies as well as a food related field.

**Name: Hunters Range Snowmobile Association Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Applicant is a member or has family members who are.
- Preference is given to someone going into a trade, small engine repair.

**Name: Interior Provincial Exhibition Award**

**Criteria:**

- Awarded to a student who is or has been involved as an IPE volunteer.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See the school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>A.L. Fortune Local Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards>Separate Applications)

**Name: Kingfisher Youth Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Students must be a resident of the Kingfisher area, living from 1730 Mabel Lake Road to Mabel Lake.
- Students may be from A.L. Fortune, a high school in the region, or home school graduates.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See the school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>A.L. Fortune Local Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards>Separate Applications)

**Name: Mara Community Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Applicants must be a resident of the Mara Community (Swansea Pointe Slide to Grindrod Bluff).
- Applicant's parent(s) or guardians(s) must be members of the MM & AA.
- Applicants must be graduating or have graduated from Secondary School.
- Applicants must be proceeding to post-secondary education (college, vocational or university).
- Preference will be given to full-time students.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See the school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>A.L. Fortune Local Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards>Separate Applications)

**Name: Mike Ludwig Memorial Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- General/All applications welcome.

**Name: North Okanagan Shuswap Principals & Vice Principals Association Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Student must represent his or her school well, within both the school and community.
- Academically strong.
- Demonstrate a commitment to the school in the role of leadership, service, and citizenship.
- Intended for a student planning to pursue post-secondary study in an area related to children, youth, or human services.
- Must be enrolled full-time in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Selected by the ALF Scholarship Committee in consultation with Principals & Vice Principals Association.
- To be paid directly to the student by the North Okanagan Shuswap Principals & Vice Principals Association based upon submission of proof of enrollment (including course registration and fee receipts) in an accredited post-secondary institution.

**Name: North Okanagan Shuswap Teachers Association Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Students must have achieved top academics.
- Must be enrolled fulltime in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient in two installments based upon submission of proof of enrollment. The proof of enrollment must be submitted for the fall term and again for the winter/spring term.

**Name: Order of the Eastern Star Bursary, Lansdowne Chapter**

**Criteria:**

- Masonic or Eastern Star affiliation preference.
- Demonstrate community involvement.
- Open to students pursuing all types of post-secondary education (tuition receipt required).
- Good grades.
- Financial need.

**Name: Patrick Romaine Memorial Award**

**Criteria:**

- Community and school involvement.
- Open to all areas of post-secondary.

**Name: Pearl Victoria Blom Memorial Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- This is open to students pursuing Health Care, Trades, or Education
- 20 hours of volunteer work either in school or in the community.
- Consideration given to those with financial need

**Name: Real Performance Machinery Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Must be enrolled fulltime in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Preference given to students pursuing a post-secondary education in Science, Engineering, Math, or Technology.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient upon submission of proof of enrollment.

**Name: Riverside Community Club Health & Social Services Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Students must be a resident of Enderby or Area F or homeschooled.
- Pursing continuing education in social work, law enforcement, medicine, psychology, or psychiatry.

**Name: Riverside Community Club Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Must be a current resident of Ashton Creek/Trinity Valley or have resided in Ashton Creek/ Trinity Valley for 3 years or more or a volunteer at the Riverside Community Hall.
- Payment will be made \*(until Sept of the following year) to the recipient upon notification and proof of payment to a post-secondary educational institution.

**Name: Rossworn Henderson LLP Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- \$500/year to be paid at beginning of year once registration into pre-determined courses has been proven. Maximum of 4 years.
- MUST attend Business Administration or Commerce, major in Accounting.
- RHLLP and recipient shall meet (in-person or virtually) within 90 days of being notified as successful recipient. Funds to be advanced directly from RHLLP to successful candidate.

**Name: Royal Canadian Legion Branch #98 Enderby General Bursary**

**Criteria:** Applicants must include 2 reference letters from members of the community/School or place of employment, (one supporting their character, one supporting their field of study). A family relation is not permitted to write this on their behalf.

- A letter addressed to the scholarship committee stating their future plans. This letter should include: their immediate plans after graduation, career goals, volunteer time, post-secondary schools applied/accepted (academic or trades), and financial plans supporting their educational goals.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See the school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>A.L. Fortune Local Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards>Separate Applications)

**Name: Royal Canadian Legion Branch #98 Enderby Poppy Fund Bursary**

**Criteria:** Applicants must include 2 reference letters from members of the community/School or place of employment, (one supporting their character, one supporting their field of study). A family relation is not permitted to write this on their behalf.

- A letter addressed to the scholarship committee stating their future plans. This letter should include: their immediate plans after graduation, career goals, volunteer time, post-secondary schools applied/accepted (academic or trades), and financial plans supporting their educational goals.
- This applicant must have proof of relationship with a current RCL Enderby #98 Member in good standing, or a documented proof of relationship to a member of their family past or present that served in the Canadian Forces or RCMP.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See the school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>A.L. Fortune Local Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards>Separate Applications)

**Name: Royal Canadian Legion British Columbia/Yukon Command Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- This applicant must have proof of relationship with a current RCL Enderby #98 Member in good standing, or a documented proof of relationship to a member of their family past or present that served in the Canadian Forces or RCMP.
- Applicants must complete a separate application form. See the school website for information and application (Students>Scholarship Opportunities>A.L. Fortune Local Scholarships, Bursaries & Awards>Separate Applications)
- This is available to 2<sup>nd</sup> year post-secondary students also.

**Name: Sam Pavelich Memorial Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Enrolled in trades.
- Students interested in heavy duty mechanics will be given priority over other trades.

**Name: Santa's Workshop Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Student who supports the community through volunteerism (e.g. Santa's workshop events).
- Must be continuing to post-secondary education.

**Name: Sarah Bradshaw Memorial Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Continuing post-secondary education in agricultural, horticultural, or environmental studies, also food related fields are acceptable.

**Name: SASCU Award**

**Criteria:**

- Student must be a member of SASCU Credit Union
- Demonstrated success and strong work ethic in field of post-secondary study.
- Enrolled at an accredited post-secondary institution for a certified certificate, vocational or trades program 6 weeks or longer or 6 credits per semester as a part-time university studies or business student including programs like Trades Apprenticeship, Trades Foundation, Education Assistant, Health Care Assistant, Early Childhood Education, Office Administration, etc. – as well as fit for part time university transfer & business student.

**Name: SASCU Scholarship**

**Criteria:**

- Academic achievement
- Community involvement OR School Involvement OR Extraordinary work ethic
- Student must be a member of SASCU Credit Union
- Student must be enrolled full-time in an accredited post-secondary learning institution.
- The scholarship must be claimed by the beginning of the second college/university year after presentation unless exceptional circumstances prevent enrollment. If the scholarship is not claimed by the second year and there are no exceptional circumstances, the funds will no longer be available as awarded.

**Name: Valley First – Enderby & District Financial Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Open to equity-deserving students which may include students who identify as BIPOC, living with disabilities, or part of the 2SLGBTQIA+ community.
- Preference given to students who demonstrate financial need.
- This award aims to support students in overcoming barriers and succeed in their higher education journey.

**Name: VantageOne Bursary**

**Criteria:**

- Must be a VantageOne member or immediate family member of a member.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Demonstrated a satisfactory level of academic achievement.
