Scholarship eligibility:

To be eligible for an *A.L. Fortune Scholarship/Bursary or Award* the following criteria **MUST** be met:

- Students must graduate in the current graduation year from A.L. Fortune.
- Students must not fail ANY course in their grade 12 year.
- Students must achieve a *minimum 60% overall course average*.
- Students must apply to the scholarship committee and submit all required documents.

Be sure your poster (you can use your Capstone poster, just tweak it slightly) contains a title, budget, scholarship resume, information about you, your achievements, and your future plans regarding post-secondary schooling. Note – you may or may not be physically present when your poster board is being viewed by all donors, so be thorough that you have displayed everything about yourself and your future plans.
